# Island Challenge

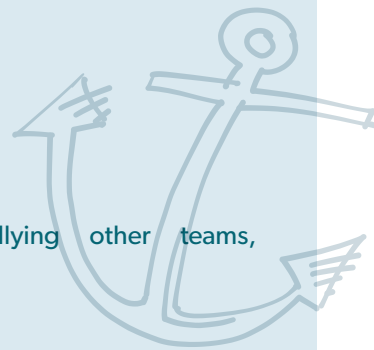
### Rules

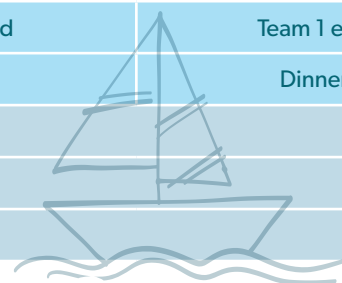
